In this month of July I want to share with you a letter written by Presiding Bishop Mark Hanson:

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

With a swiftness that we could not have imagined only weeks ago, the waters have brought chaos to a large area of the central United States. The flooding that is moving south in the Mississippi River valley follows unusually destructive tornadoes in several states and the humanitarian crisis after an immigration raid in Postville, Iowa. The scope is broad. Tornadoes have caused fatalities in fifteen states, and at least eleven synods currently are involved in relief operations with ELCA Domestic Disaster Response, an unprecedented number in our history.

In the midst of these disasters, Scripture speaks to us. "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change, though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea; though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble with its tumult." (Psalm 46:1-3) God remains faithful. God's Spirit is at work, moving over the face of the waters to renew life and hope. This hope will not disappoint, because God's love is being poured out through the Holy Spirit.

I write to ask you to join me in prayer and action. Please pray for all who are facing adversity, including the hidden challenges that seep in after media attention leaves: the destruction of this year's crop and the productivity of cropland for years to come; the loss of homes and neighborhoods; the severing of ties from each other and histories in particular places; and the troubling emotions and thoughts that erode confidence and faith. Pray that God's Spirit will sustain them in the hope of God's faithfulness, shown to us in Jesus Christ.

"Humble yourselves, therefore under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on Him because he cares for you." - I Peter 5:6-7

In a few days we will celebrate the Fourth of July – a day we set aside to remember our declaration of independence from foreign rule back in 1776. Our colonial forefathers had a dream that one day they might live in a nation that is free – free to create its own laws, free to create its own constitution; and free to elect its own leaders. The cost for that liberty came at a huge price in human life and suffering. Throughout history, our freedom has been put to the test, but we have always prevailed because men and women of all creeds colors, nationalities, and religions have fought together, side by side, to help preserve that liberty.

As modern day Christians we enjoy freedom of another kind. We should all be free from anxiety because we know that God is ultimately in charge. He will provide for us, no matter what the circumstances. We are His children, and He really cares deeply for each and every one of us. It's hard to trust in God for all that we need. Gas prices are reaching \$4.00 a gallon and beyond. Our country is still at war. Food prices are rising out of control. And in few months we will elect a new president to lead our land. Uncertainty abounds, but only if you let in to your hearts.

The God of Jacob is our stronghold. Jesus has conquered sin and death. Through the body and blood of our Lord, our victory is assured. So instead of bemoaning our fate, let us rejoice in our daily blessings and be thankful for all our Father has given us. Amen.

FIRST ST. JOHN LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES—JUNE 17, 2008

President Bill Caldwell brought the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. Sherrie Haar led devotions. Roll call was taken. LuAnn Schuffenecker made a motion to approve the May minutes. Bernie Erdmann seconded the motion – motion carried.

Bill Caldwell spoke on the attendance at our church services and discussed different options for service times.

TREASURER'S REPORT/FINANCE

COMMITTEE – Jim Sommers reported we need \$6200 a week in the current fund to meet budget. We were \$3700 ahead, but we got behind in May, and June is worse. Maintenance has already used 60% of its budget. Jim and Lisa were able to get a 60 day extension on our loan option while we wait for an estimate on the back parking lot. Larry Paul made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Linda Kusian seconded the motion – motion carried. The Youth's books were audited by Duane Hubaker and were found to be in order. The Youth used to have a debit card, but the finance committee would rather see them have a credit card. Mike Folk made a motion to get a resolution to get a credit card. Lynn Folk seconded the motion – motion carried. The Dayschool area could use an upgrade by painting. An estimate was received at \$6592. Dayschool would be willing to pay \$2000. The remainder could come from the improvement loan.

BOARD OF EDUCATION – Pam Beavers reported they canceled Summer Sunday School for the 3 year olds through the 6th grade due to lack of attendance. Abbie Skorupa will be in charge of Vacation Bible School. The board will meet next month to discuss Rally Day and the fall schedule.

ELDERS – Bernie Erdmann reported Darold Henninger and Mark Ackerman worked on the speaker system. They were checking on the wedding schedule.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT - Mike Folk

reported Eric Johnson accepted the open position. Mike welcomed Eric.

Completed items: the parking lot across the street has been resealed and re-striped;

a faucet in the secretary's office was fixed; a broken water line in the cemetery was fixed. The garage doors were adjusted. Two toilets in the Dayschool were repaired. Cardboard recycling seems to be working well. If you can help, please take a load out to Pearson Park.

They are looking for estimates for either asphalt or concrete for the back parking lot.

There was no progress report on air conditioning. Ron Witt did some tuck point on the garage, and Gene Schacht will be doing some varnishing.

YOUTH – Bill Caldwell reported they have ads out for a new director. So far one application has arrived. Mike and Lynn Folk and Lisa Anderson are lining up the King's Island trip.

PASTOR – Pastor Blohm reported the following transfer: Michael and Kathleen Sherwood to St. Stephens Lutheran in Sylvania.

New Members: Melanie Grady and Ashley Grady and Julie Stausmire and Kari Stausmire to First St. John.

Bernie Erdmann made a motion to accept the transfer and new members. Dick Haar seconded the motion – motion carried.

Bob Haar reported that the Men's Ministry meetings are being attended by between 10 and 14 men. The next one will be July 5th at 8 a.m. at Frisch's on Navarre Ave.

OLD BUSINESS – There will be a chaperone meeting for King's Island. Lynn Folk is making arrangements for the trip.

NEW BUSINESS – There will be no meeting scheduled for July and August. Bill Caldwell asked council to pray for help in planning service times for the fall.

Pastor Blohm closed the meeting with everyone praying the Lord's Prayer at 8:40 p.m.
