**FINANCE COMMITTEE** – Jim Sommers reported our loan is at \$98,646 and our payments are \$768 per month. By taking money from the Debt Fund and Improvement Fund we could lower that loan balance to about \$51,000 and redo the loan to get our payments down to \$385 per month.

TREASURER'S REPORT – Lisa Anderson reported our Sept. contributions were about \$20,000 and our disbursements were \$19,000. Disbursements were down because of the two salaries not being paid. Joanne Henningsen made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Gary Henningsen seconded the motion – motion carried. Lisa suggested we have a treasurer's assistant to cover her when she's not available. Mike Folk made a motion to appoint Jim Sommers as assistant treasurer. Gary Henningsen seconded the motion – motion carried.

BOARD OF EDUCATION – Pam Beavers reported 50 to 60 kids are attending Sunday School each week. They are working on ways to bring in more kids. Betty Hyre has volunteered to take charge of the Christmas program that will be held Dec. 21 during the Sunday School hour. There will be no Sunday School the Sunday after Thanksgiving or the Sunday between Christmas and New Year's. The teachers like the new Augsburg material.

YOUTH – Mike Folk reported there was a meeting Oct. 5 to share information and seek input from SALGHT students and parents. A game night was held on Oct. 18. A total of 20 attended including 10 youth, 8 adults, Rachel and Amy Ackerman.
