**HELP WANTED – CEMETERY CARETAKER:** The Cemetery committee is looking for someone to take over the duties of cemetery caretaker. This is a part time paid position on an as-needed basis. These duties are now being performed by volunteers. (**Note:** Mowing and grave digging is not part of this job, as it is handled by individual contractors.) This position reports to First St John Lutheran Church Cemetery Committee and performs duties pertaining to the administration of burials as well as physical upkeep of the landscape and grave sites of the church cemetery.

#### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Coordinates with First St John Lutheran Church clergy, staff and funeral directors in locating and marking graves for burial.
- Communicates with church staff to confirm suitability of grave sites for burial and provides information necessary for good record keeping.
- Present for all excavation, funeral services and back filling of graves.
- Levels and grass seeds new graves.
- Removes all weeds and debris from grave sites.
- Sprays weeds and fertilizes when necessary.
- Identifies grave markers that need maintenance and coordinates with the cemetery committee to take corrective action.
- Provide cost of any additional services required to Cemetery Committee for approval.
- Always maintains a safe working environment.
- Follows all written rules and regulations pertaining to First St John Lutheran Church Cemetery.
